

SPALDING TOWNSHIP CEMETERY RULES

Purchasers of Cemetery lots acquire the right and privilege of burial of the dead, and constructing markers, vaults and monuments subject to the rules and regulations therefore hereinafter prescribed.

All caskets must be placed in a vault before burial in the Spalding Township Cemetery.

Trees, shrubs, are not allowed to be planted on cemetery grounds. Perennials maybe planted but if they are over grown and not maintained the sexton will be allowed to trim or remove upon approval of the township board. All annual flowers are allowed within a border. No plant, flower, tree or shrub may be taken out of the cemetery without the permission of the Sexton. Any decorations blown around by the wind will be discarded.

If any trees or shrubs situated in any lot, shall, in the opinion of the Township Board, become by means of their roots, branches or in any other way detrimental to the adjacent lots, streets, alleys or walks, or prejudicial to the general appearance of the grounds, or dangerous or inconvenient to passengers, the Board shall have the right to remove said trees or shrubs or such parts thereof as they may consider detrimental, dangerous or inconvenient.

The Sexton or his assistant is required to be in attendance at every interment and all funerals on reaching the grounds shall be in charge of the Sexton.

Grave lots, (full, half & quarter,) are purchased from Spalding Township. Single spaces cannot be purchased. Perpetual Care must be paid at time of purchase.

Grave Opening and Closing Fee must be paid on or before burial day. This fee is to be paid to Spalding Township.

Funeral Homes must give two days notice of burial. Spalding Township does not do it's own grave excavating, therefore we require the two day notice to notify the private excavator.

We require a 14 day notice as to the delivery of monuments. Granite companies are to contact either the sexton or township board prior to installing bases and stones and give dimensions of the base so cemetery personel have ample time to stake out the site.

Spalding Township allows the family to select the type of base or foundation for monuments placed in the Spalding Township Cemetery from the monument company. The seller of the base or foundation will provide all future maintenance. Bases or Foundation maybe no wider than 20 inches. All bases are to be installed so they protrude two inches above the surface of the ground. Any questions call the sexton at 906-497-5850.

Burials will not be permitted on any lot until Perpetual Care & Grave Opening fees have been

paid.

Lot owners are requested to remove from lots and graves, all wilted and dead flowers and faded decorations and deposit them in refuse cans or in places designated for their deposit or refuse. The township board, sexton and cemetery worker aren't responsible for any damage to plants, flowers, decorations etc. that are not confined within a plastic protective border. Upkeep of area within any protective border, plants, flowers, and any type of decoration are the responsibility of the lot owner or persons who installed the items. Any water containers, tools or equipment etc. left behind at cemetery will be removed.

Spring burials must take place at least one week before Memorial Day.
